STORE & OTM CATTLE**

Wallets Marts Castle Douglas Limited sold 300 Store and OTM cattle at their fortnightly sale.

Store cattle easily maintained the buoyant trade of a fortnight ago with 8 month old cattle being the dearest yet. Topping the sale at £1180 was a pen of five Simmentals bullocks from TC Brown & Sons, Trowdale. Scaling 546kgs they sold to David Carins, Hexham. This was closely followed at £1170 for an Aberdeen Angus from Muncraig and £1160 for Charolais crosses from Park Farm, Shawhead. Top price per kilo in the bullocks section was 239.6p paid to Messrs Brough, Cotland for a pen of six Charolais crosses. Heifers were dearer than the last sale selling to £1060 for British Blue crosses from S & L Asbery, Hill of Balmaghie. This was closely followed at £960 for a pen of Shorthorns from Messrs Stewart, Mayhaar. Top price per kilo in the heifer section was 219.8p for a pen of Charolais crosses off M & G Barr, Meikle Kirkland.

Overall averages levelled at 209.1p for bullocks (-0.9p on the last sale) and 200.8p for heifers (+7p on last sale). The whole sale averaged £820.30 a rise of £165.03 on last sale.

69 OTM cattle were forward to the usual ringside of buyers and all classes easily maintained recent high rates. Top price per kilo for cows was 160p for a Luing from Muncraig, followed at 151p for a Limousin from West Auchensheen. Top price per head of £1124 for an Aberdeen Angus from Balgerran, followed at £1058 for another Angus this time from Cotland. Bulls to 137p or £1096 for a Limousin from Redfield

Wallets Marts Castle Douglas Limited had forward 2064 prime and cast sheep at their weekly sale. The 1773 prime hogs were a very mixed show with plain sheep hard to cash, any good meated hogs in demand. Overall average was 201.6p (+19.5p on corresponding week last year) to a top of 250p or £100 for Beltex's from Lagganpark. Next top per kilo was 231p for Texels from Douganhill, with best meated export hogs regularly 215-230p. Heavy hogs to £98.50 for Texels from Killochy.

The 291 cast ewes and rams meet extreme rates to £127 and £126 for Texel ewes from Crofts, Carsphairn. Mule ewes to £97.50 off Torhousekie and Blackfaces to £79.50 off Barlure.
